

Indiana Section ARES DMR Net Script

This net takes place on Tuesdays @ 7:00 PM EST on the Indiana 3118 Talk-group.

CQ Net, CQ Net, CQ Net. This is **[YOUR CALL phonetically]** activating the ARRL Indiana Section Amateur Radio Emergency Service DMR Net. This net meets every Tuesday @ 7:00 PM EST on the Indiana 3118 Talk-group.

Stations with Emergency or Priority traffic may interrupt this net at any time!

The purpose of this net to discuss topics important to our ability to support public safety and emergency communications throughout the Indiana Section. All stations with and interest in public service and emergency communications are welcome to participate. This is a directed net, so please hold all comments until directed by net control. The net control for this session is **[YOUR CALL]** and my name is **[YOUR NAME]**.

Be advised that this net is operating on a shared timeslot and may experience interruption from traffic on another talk-group on the slot. Should such an interruption occur, we will stand by until the timeslot has cleared and resume the net.

Do we have an alternate net control for this session? Thank you **[ALTERNATES CALL]** for volunteering, do you have any comments or traffic for the net? *(Skip if no one volunteers.)*

When checking in to this net please slowly state your full FCC call sign, your name and county as well as if you have traffic or comments for the net. Check-ins will be called according to district number order. *(Start with district # relating to the current month, in Nov/Dec start with Net controls district #)*

This is [YOUR CALL] for the ARRL Indiana Section ARES DMR Net *(Make sure to identify every 10 minutes)*

[District check-ins] This is the ARRL Indiana Section DMR net, all stations in District #XX please call now.

(Acknowledge check-ins and ask for comments)

(When complete with current district, move to the next district and repeat)

This is [YOUR CALL] for the ARRL Indiana Section ARES DMR Net *(Make sure to identify every 10 minutes)*

[Open Check-ins] This is the ARRL Indiana Section DMR ARES net looking for check-ins from any Indiana district.

[Net Announcements] List any comments or announcement that net control has for the net.)

[Late Check-ins] Are there any late check-ins?

(Acknowledge late check-ins)

This is [YOUR CALL] for the ARRL Indiana Section ARES DMR Net (Make sure to identify every 10 minutes)

Are there any questions, comments or traffic for the net?

[Closing] There being no further comments or announcements for the net, I would like to thank my alternate net control **[ALTERNATES CALL]** as well as everyone for their participation, I would also like to thank the HoosierDMR, CrossroadsDMR and all other groups with repeaters on the Indiana 3118 state-wide talk-group for the use of the repeaters.
